

## 1. Introduction

To access your personal homepage which was given to you before the migration of all IT services to the central IT department, the below instructions will help you do so.

## 2. Via WinSCP on a Windows platform

Go to <https://winscp.net/eng/download.php> and click on *Portable executables*. The download will start shortly. Open winscp576.zip with a zip file manager (like 7-zip).

Click on WinSCP.exe and *Extract* the file to a folder of choice.


Open the program WinSCP.exe and enter the following information:

- Host name: sftp.data.vu.nl
- User name: <Your VUnet ID>
- Password: <Your password>


Click *Advanced...*

Click on *Connection* and change the *Server response timeout* to 120 seconds.


Click *Ok* to confirm these advanced settings and click *Login* to login to the file server.




The following warning might appear, Click *Yes* to continue.



When the connection is successful for the first time, the *Authentication Banner* will show up. It's optional to check the box *Never show this banner again*. Click *Continue*.




On the right side of the program, you see your files. Click on *Open directory/bookmark* (or use Ctrl + O).



Enter the following path:

- For your personal homepage:
  - /mnt/personal/few/<YourFormerFEW\_FALWLoginName>
  - /mnt/personal/falw/<YourFormerFEW\_FALWLoginName>
- For your group homepage:
  - /mnt/group/<YourGroupSite>

Click *Ok* to continue.




Start editing *index.htm* by double clicking the file in WinSCP. If there is no *index.htm*, make a text file and save this under the name *index.htm*.



### 3. Via Webdrive


Start Webdrive from the start menu. Add a new connection by clicking *New* and click *SFTP* and then click on *Next*.




On the next page enter the following information:

- Url / Address: sftp.data.vu.nl
- Username: <Your VUnet-ID>
- Password: <Your password>

Next, press *Advanced Settings*.




Click on *Connection Settings* and type for the *Command timeout (seconds)*: 120.




Click on SFTP Settings and type the following path in the Root Directory section:

- For your personal homepage:
  - /mnt/personal/few/<YourFormerFEW\_FALWLoginName>
  - /mnt/personal/falw/<YourFormerFEW\_FALWLoginName>
- For your group homepage:
  - /mnt/group/<YourGroupSite>



On the bottom left click on the tab “Basic Cache Settings”. Perform the following steps (in order):

1. Turn off the checkbox *inherit global settings*
2. Set the Cache Mode to *Custom*
3. Check all checkboxes such that they are all checked. The number values can remain at their default value.




Next press *Ok* and then press *Next*.

On the next screen you can choose a name for the connection, such as “FEW/FALW website”. Next, pick an unused drive letter to which the connection will be linked. If you wish to automatically connect when you log in to your computer, check the checkbox *Connect at login/startup*.

Finally, press *Finish*.

Webdrive is now setup to connect to your FEW/FALW website file.




Go to Windows Explorer and go to your chosen path. Start editing *index.htm* by double clicking. If there is no *index.htm*, make a text file and save this under the name *index.htm*.
